**Moment for Mission**

This month our outreach offering will assist Janus Center. This is a program of the Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport that assists young people ages 11-17 facing serious problems with their families, schools, or the juvenile court. During a normal school year, the social workers have regular office hours in eight schools in Bridgeport and Stratford, and work with the faculty to identify students in need of intervention. They provide a 24-hour Youth in Crisis Hotline, counseling and referrals to necessary services. The Janus Center has host families to provide short term respite care if a youth cannot return home immediately and isn't under state care. They have begun offering parenting classes to help the families learn to manage family issues. They have also begun offering monthly family events to help the families bond.
